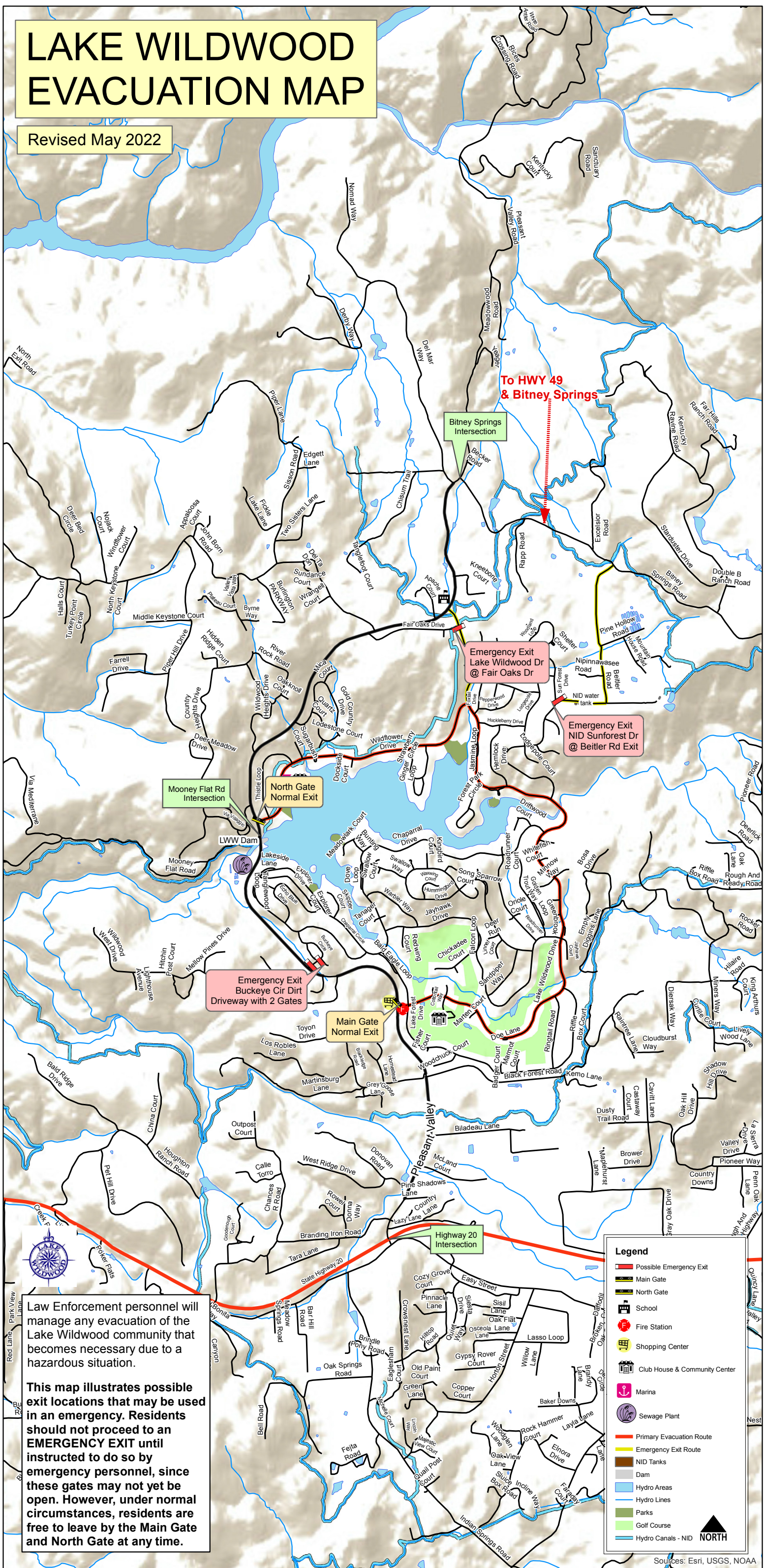


LAKE WILDWOOD EVACUATION MAP

Be Prepared.

Be Sure You Can Find Each Evacuation Exit and Highway Intersection.

Leave Early.

Evacuating from a wildfire at Lake Wildwood could be very stressful and become very confusing. Prepare now so you will be familiar with the roads and be able to think more clearly if you have to evacuate.

You must evacuate through the Main Gate or the North Gate unless traffic control directs otherwise. **It would be dangerous and could become fatal to you and others if you try to use an emergency exit unless you are directed to by traffic control.** Emergency exits require communication and coordination among law enforcement officials to make them safe for use.

The labels in green boxes on the map show the access points to main corridors of escape once you have exited from Lake Wildwood.

Highway 20 Intersection leads towards either Grass Valley or Marysville.

Mooney Flat Road Intersection. You can take Mooney Flat Road to Highway 20 going towards Marysville.

Bitney Springs Road Intersection. You can take Bitney Springs Road east towards Grass Valley, or continue on Pleasant Valley Road towards the Yuba River and north.
